TRASH PICKUP DELAYS

SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT has been having problems keeping up with collection schedules for several months. City council has approved the purchase of new trucks to help alleviate the problems. The mayor has also lifted the hiring freeze for drivers and mechanics to fill a significant number of vacancies.
