### Curbs and Gutters Project

Please be advised that the project is in full swing. Triple B Services is actively working on the park, albeit a bit slow. The project timeline is however not impacted, the weather has been the primary culprit for delays. Here's the current planned items for March:

- Subcontractor to start fencing, protecting, pruning and removing trees along roadway.
- Surveying will be marking right of way (ROW) on properties as previous stakes were removed.
- ROW marking will allow Triple B Services (TBS) to begin installing the waterline on the northern limits of the project.
- TBS will start working storm water on Brickhouse Gully outfall to ValleyField Dr.
- All neighbors affected by these plans will be notified.

## ARCHITECTURAL COMMITTEE

The Architectural Committee meets on a bi-weekly basis to discuss ongoing and future home improvement projects. This is a voluntary committee that considers the best interest of the community as a whole in regards to making any decisions on requests for exterior renovations and improvements such as: roof replacement, painting, concrete work (walkways/driveways), fencing, etc.

Some tips to consider prior to submitting an architectural approval request:

- Be familiar with the bylaws and deed restrictions in your section
- Be aware that majority of the Binglewood community is in a 100-year flood plan.
- Please contact the Civic Club prior to applying for any city permits.
- When submitting an architectural approval include all drawings and designs.
- The architectural committee typically makes a decision within 30-days.
