CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

Construction work planned for March:

- Paving operations will continue at Colleen and Valleyfield, the west half of Laverne and the intersections for cul-de-sacs on Colleen will be poured.
- McKean between Eldora and Springview will have the 60" RCP installed followed by High Early Strength Paving done in sections.
- Autauga will have subgrade prepared followed by paving on the north half of the street.
- Subgrade and paving operations will begin on Pitner Rd.
- Mona Lee Ln. cul-de-sac east half will be poured once concrete breaks come in.
- RCB storm boxes for Mona Lee Ln. will be delivered the last week of February and stored on site until operations begin following approval.

If you have questions about how your driveway/walkway will connect to the street, or if you plan to replace additional driveway/walkway at your own expense, contact Joe Almaguer (832-465-0172), Triple B Services, to schedule an on-site meeting prior to construction occurring on your street. Inform him of your plans and discuss your issues and/or concerns.

- Place at the curb after 6 pm the Friday before collection date.
- Avoid placing close to mailboxes, fire hydrants, light poles or other possible obstructions.
- "Tree Waste" includes wood waste such as tree limbs and branches.
- "Junk Waste" includes furniture, appliances, 1-4 tires, and other bulky material.
- Residents may choose to take waste to any Neighborhood Depository or Recycling Center

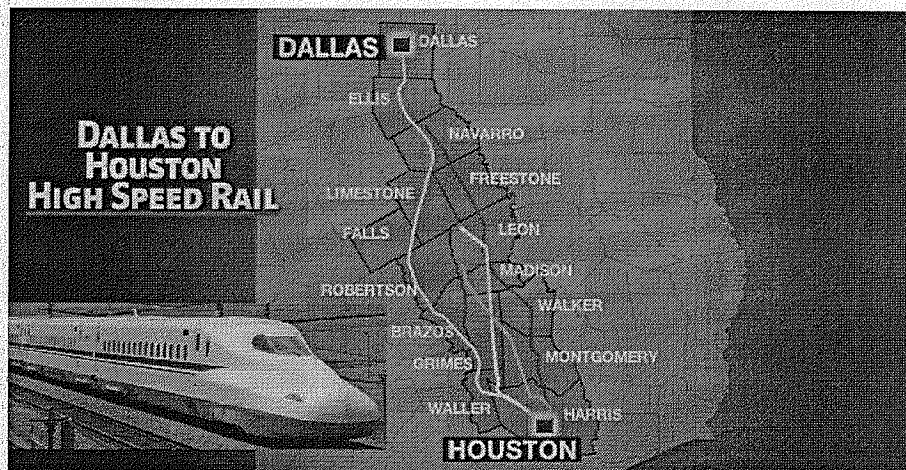

THE BULLET TRAIN IS COMING

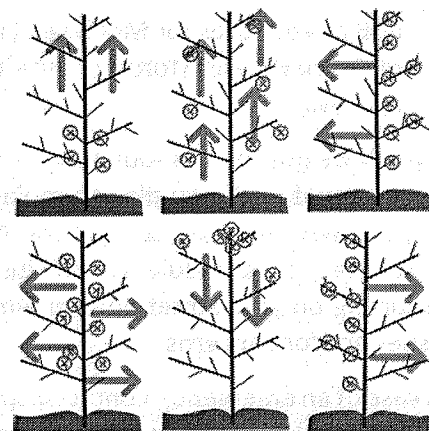
The bullet train is coming! Nearly 50,000 Texans travel back and forth between Houston and Dallas/Fort Worth more than once a week. The rail line will offer a total travel time of less than 90 minutes, with departures every 30 minutes during peak periods, to hourly. The departure station will be at the old Northwest Mall on Hempstead Highway.

Texas Central is a private Texas-based company not using public funds. It's based on Central Japan Railway's Tokaido Shinkansen train system with more than 54 years of zero passenger fatalities or injuries while maintaining an on-time performance record. Construction may begin in 2019.
