Guidelines for Trash and Recycling Containers
(Rev. 07/17)

Black rolling garbage cans:

Should be placed in front of your home no earlier than 6 p.m. Thursday, facing so it opens toward the street. After it is emptied on Friday, it should be stored either behind your fence or in your garage, out of view from the street, no later than 10 p.m. on Friday. Do not put the following items in your garbage cans:

Household chemicals, Construction, demolition or remodeling debris, Dead animals, computer equipment

Green rolling garbage cans:

Is emptied *every other* Friday. The same rules apply when you place it in front of your home and return it to its place – out no earlier than 6 p.m. Thursday, facing so it opens toward the street. After it is emptied on Friday, it should be stored either behind your fence or in your garage, out of view from the street, no later than 10 p.m. on Friday. ONLY place recyclable materials in the green can.

Items accepted for recycling, for example, are:

Recyclable plastics #1-#5; #7 (please rinse & drain and NO plastic BAGS or soft #4 wrapping of products), Aluminum/tin cans, Corrugated cardboard, Mail, Newspapers.

Tree/Junk Waste – Fourth (4th) Thursday of the month

(Schedules changes from month to month)

Tree Waste is collected: JANUARY, MARCH, MAY, JULY, SEPTEMBER & NOVEMBER

Tree waste is defined as “clean wood waste” such as: Tree limbs, Branches, Stumps

Junk Waste is collected: FEBRUARY, APRIL, JUNE, AUGUST, OCTOBER & DECEMBER

Junk waste is defined as items such as: Furniture, Appliances, Bulky materials/items

Please Note: Junk waste may not be placed for collection during a Tree Waste Month **BUT** Tree waste is accepted during Junk waste months. However, to make sure your Tree/Junk items are recycled, you can take it to the Sommermeyer Neighborhood Depository.

Heavy Trash Depository

Our neighborhood depository is the Sommermeyer Neighborhood Depository conveniently located at (have a current proof of residency with you – e.g. current City of Houston water bill):

If you miss heavy trash day or do not want to wait for heavy trash day, you can go to the Sommermeyer facility. Residents may use the depository up to 4 times a month, and are encouraged to arrive at least 30 minutes before closing to allow adequate time to unload. Each user must provide proof of residency (TLD/ID card and current utility bill or property tax receipt).
