TREASURER'S REPORT

Binglewood has six sections with a total of 714 homes. Each section has its own deed restrictions. Sections 1-5 dues for the Civic Club are voluntary while Section 6 dues are mandatory. **Dues are only \$50 annually.** As of June 1, 2021, we have collected dues from **only 12.6% of all the homes in Binglewood!** Here is the current breakdown of Civic Club participation by Section: Section 1 - 10.23%, Section 2 - 8.7%, Section 3 - 9.8%, Section 4 - 15.4%, Section 5 - 5.7% and Section 6 - 42.6%. **Thank you to all who have paid their annual dues!** Your dues cover mowing and trash removal from the area adjacent to Clay Road and ditch maintenance along Hollister St., legal fees to enforce compliance, insurance, sign maintenance, doggy waste bags at the park and any new projects we want such as the Community Garden and fixing the cement pillar street signs throughout the neighborhood.
