PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Positive changes are coming! Your Civic Club Board and Officers met last month and decided to make some changes to the way we communicate with you. Since there has been a noticeable drop off in attendance at the Saturday morning monthly meetings, it was decided to change the number of meetings we offer each year. For 2023, we are going to hold only five (5) total meetings during the year instead of every month. We selected January, April, July, September and December as our Civic Club meeting months for 2023.

And, since Saturday is a day for family time, errands and getting some well-deserved rest, we are also changing our meetings to Wednesday evenings. We also don't want to make them too long with enough time to share needed information, to listen to our neighbors and still get home in time for dinner so we will change to a one-hour meeting format from 6:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. All meetings will still be held in the same place, at St, Jerome's in the New Activity Center (**Room A this year**) just past Kempwood off of Hollister.
