COMPLIANCE MATTERS

We will be notifying all residents in violation of our Deed Restrictions, Policies and Guidelines or City of Houston ordinances this month. If you receive a notice, please comply within 10 days of receipt to avoid a certified letter and attorney letter notifying you of legal action. Parking of trailers in the front or side yard are a primary focus since it affects the aesthetics of our neighborhood. You cannot store work vehicles and trailers in your front yard or use your home for business purposes! These are violations of our Deed Restrictions and Policies!

COYOTE SIGHTINGS

Since the loss of wooded property in Spring Branch due to development, coyotes have been spotted in Binglewood. Be sure to keep small pets inside at night. Also, avoid leaving pet food outside. If you see a coyote, make some loud noise such as banging a spoon against a metal pan or honking your horn to encourage them to leave the area for their safety as well.
