Constable Patrol Update

Binglewood Civic Club



Constable Program-Collections

Goal: \$88,700 annually; Final Status: 83.75% or \$74,290.36

- ❑ We had almost enough funds to get us through July so the Civic Club donated the rest to make the \$7,392 monthly payment.
- ❑ Because we will not have enough to continue the program, we submitted our 30-day notice and, unfortunately, despite our best efforts, will no longer have a constable patrol as of July 31st.
- ❑ In the end, we had 264 total neighbors contribute at least once and 48 of those contributed twice or more so we never reached our 350 goal.
- ❑ We have collected more funds for this program than at any time in the history of Binglewood!
- ❑ We only needed 86 more people to donate \$250 but could not get there.
- ❑ We are looking at other security measures we can afford like fixing fencing and adding cameras.

HPD PIP Meetings Are Back!

When: the 3rd Tuesday of the month at 7pm so July 18th is next meeting!

Last year there were over 4400 guns stolen from vehicles- this alarming number has been on the rise! To combat this, The Houston Police Department has joined with the Spring Branch Management District, Harris County District Attorney's office and Academy to provide 1000 vehicle gun safes to our community.

If you join us at our monthly PIP meetings, you will be given a gun safe to install in your vehicle. This first meeting, we will have 100 safes to give out to those that carry a gun in their vehicle! This is a first come first serve for these initial 100 safes!

We will start the presentation at 7:00pm with announcements and information regarding crime from the Division Commander. Sgt Tracy Hicks will present information regarding the gun safes and their value in Burglary of a Motor Vehicle prevention! At the end of the presentation, the safes will be given away!
