

James William Hajovsky October 15, 1941 – October 9, 2023

James William Hajovsky, long-time Binglewood resident and former President of the Civic Club, passed away in October. James and his wife, Claudia, have lived in Section 5 of Binglewood since 1968. To his core, James was dedicated to helping others and he remained undeterred by progressive physical limitations. He volunteered for many years with the Stephen Ministry and the Disabled in Action Ministry, dedicated to ending discrimination against people with disabilities.

James was a founding partner of Spring Spirit, a program that provides safe pathways for youth to realize life opportunities through sports, education, and mentoring programs based on Christian principles. As a member of the first community engagement team, James made a significant difference in the lives of over 8,000 youth and sent dozens to college who would not otherwise have had such a life-changing opportunity.

James was a much-valued member of our community. He cared deeply about his neighbors and happily welcomed new residents, never neglecting to mention the Binglewood Civic Club. James served as a Binglewood Civic Club officer for many years. He was voted in as President *eight times*. As President, James established strong relationships with our local elected officials. At a transformative community meeting held in July 2006 attended by many local officials, he and his son, Chris, presented well-documented data that brought needed attention to several issues including increasing crime rates and the overrepresentation of subsidized apartments within Spring Branch. Their efforts ensured the Civic Club's place as a force to be reckoned with and helped to create the neighborhood we live in today. James will be greatly missed by his Binglewood family.

Tips to avoid becoming a victim of auto crime.

- Hide your valuables from plain sight.
- Lock your vehicle and take your keys.
- Never hide a second set of keys in or on
- Park in well-lit areas or attended lots.
- Never leave your vehicle running unattended, even if you will only be away for a moment.
- Don't leave documents with important personal details such as the car title or insurance card in your vehicle. Carry your insurance card in your purse or wallet.
- Park with your wheels turned toward the curb and use your emergency brake, making it less easy to tow away.
- Your vehicle may be more vulnerable when you park it outside. Park it in the garage if you have one and lock your vehicle and the garage door.
- Disable your vehicle when leaving it unattended for an extended period.
- Engrave your VIN or personal ID number on windows and expensive accessories and parts.
- Have an ignition or fuel kill switch installed by a qualified person.
- Use security devices to protect your vehicle, such as steering wheel locks, pedal locks, and gearshift locks.
- Install alarm systems for your vehicle.
- Install a vehicle tracker.

JUNK AND TREE WASTE

Binglewood is a great neighborhood to live in because residents take pride in maintaining their homes. However, not everyone is following the guidelines and schedules for Junk and Tree Waste Collections. Binglewood is scheduled for the fourth Thursday of the month, with possible exceptions for holidays.

JUNK WASTE: Even Months (February, April, June, August, October, December)

Tree Waste is allowable during these months.

TREE WASTE: Odd Months (January, March, May, July, September, November)

Junk waste is not allowed during Tree Waste months.

- Place the waste adjacent to the curb, not in the street, in an accessible location, between 6:00 pm on the Friday before and 7:00 am of the scheduled collection day.
- Landscape and construction contractors are responsible for the removal of their debris and waste.
- If your waste is not picked up within a few days after the scheduled date, contact 311. Be sure to make note of the case number.

The SWMD website offers all the detail you need on their website, City of Houston Solid Waste Management Department (houstontx.gov). You can download the HTX COLLECTS App, available on Google Play and the Apple App Store, which offers a selection of helpful tools including a calendar and alerts.

Tips for Buying a Used Vehicle

- Be suspicious of any deal that seems too good to be true. Use a reliable resource to research the vehicle.
- Use online resources to check the vehicle's history by using the VIN. Check the TxDMV.gov website or NICB.org. or try CarFax.com
- Ask the seller for references about past financing and insurance on the vehicle. Verify it with a bank or other financial institution. Request to see the seller's license or a legal identification card.
- When buying from a private individual, ask to see the title and match the seller's identity with the information on the title.
- Question the seller if the registration was recently issued on an older vehicle. Be cautious of new license plates on an old vehicle, or new plate bolts on an older license plate.
- The VIN plate on the dash should be secure and have no loose rivets. Match the VIN plate to the VIN on the registration, title and safety inspection sticker.
- Make sure the federal safety sticker, located on the driver's door jamb, is securely in place and has not been tampered with.
- Beware of a loose dashboard or excessively loose ignition switch. Check the switch for chisel or pull marks.
- Be wary of a fresh paint job on a newer vehicle.
- Check the inspection documentation and registration sticker to be sure they are current and issued by the same state.
- If the seller provides you with only remade keys for a newer model, be suspicious.



TO PLANT OR NOT TO PLANT -- WEEPING WILLOW TREES

The following information was excerpted from an online Southern Living article by Steve Bender, May 2023

The Weeping Willow Tree is a very fast growing, thirsty tree. They grow to be 30-50 feet tall with trunks from 1-3 feet wide. They require lots of water, and do best when planted near a body of fresh water, such as a pond or lake with nothing else around. Weeping

Willows have highly invasive and very aggressive water-seeking root systems. The roots require at least 120 feet of unobstructed space to spread. That's almost half the length of a football field! For this reason, they don't belong near the owner's home, a neighbor's home, driveway, sidewalk, pool, water or sewer lines. To plant one anywhere close to your foundation or water or sewer lines is to court disaster for you and your neighbors.

If you are contemplating planting a willow tree in your yard, *please don't*. If you have planted one, please consider removing it as soon as possible to prevent further damage to water and sewer pipes on or near your property.

If you live near someone with a willow tree, please share this information with them. Also, pay close attention to your water and sewer lines on your property and check for damage. Call 311 to have the City check for problems.

AIRBNB RENTALS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN BINGLEWOOD! WE ENFORCE OUR DEED RESTRICTIONS AND POLICIES!

We continue to see from time-to-time, realtors and homeowners advertising their homes for sale as available for Airbnb rentals. Statements such as, "Home features a second primary bedroom suite as a possible AirBnB[sic]" are not allowed (see below) and we will send a notice to the realtor and/or homeowner that such statements are incorrect and misleading to any prospective purchaser.

We often hear from some of our neighbors that they bought a home in Binglewood because "there is no HOA so Deed Restrictions are not enforced." The Binglewood Civic Club is a POA-property owner's association-and, as it says on all of our signs leading into the neighborhood, "Deed Restrictions Enforced." Without the Civic Club, individual homeowners would have to enforce Deed Restrictions on their own by dealing with the City or County alone or sending a letter or filing a lawsuit and incurring legal fees to get something fixed. A POA gives you a collective voice, protects your property values and, more importantly, your quality of life in Binglewood!

Binglewood's Policies and Guidelines directly state: **Section VI.s. and m.**

- s. Short-Term Rentals.
 - Subdivision residents may not rent or lease their property for less than thirty (30) days. Airbnb or other similar short-term rentals qualify as a "lease" and a "business or commercial activity" under the Deed Restrictions and are not permitted.

m. Additional Living Quarters.

- Additional living quarters, which are referred to as "servants' quarters" or
 "servants' house" in the Deed Restrictions, shall mean any additional
 living quarters added to a Lot with or without utility service not attached
 to the main residence which may be added to the backyard of any Lot
 such as a "mother-in-law" or garden apartment, art studio, workshop, etc.
 In accordance with the Deed Restrictions, all such additional living
 quarters must be occupied by family members of the Lot Owner and/or a
 person contracted to provide certain healthcare or other life extending
 services to the Lot Owner.
- 2. Such additional living quarters must be connected to the main house in some way, shall be no taller than the residence and shall be erected more than sixty-five (65) feet from the front property line and more than five (5) feet on either side of the property line in the backyard. All setback and easement requirements as set forth in the Deed Restrictions shall apply.
- 3. The Architectural Committee must approve any additional living quarters added to any Lot.
